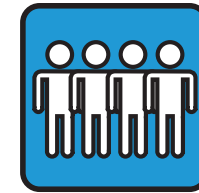


REDUCTION OF ILLITERACY LEVEL AMONG ORPHANS WITH DISABILITIES IN TASHKENT GION

Background:

The situation with orphans is very actual in Uzbekistan now because they need more attention and special educative programs in order to grow as the developed personalities. Therefore, they need special approach in education.
